Cookie policy Terms & Conditions

A cookie is a text file that is stored on your computer or mobile device to make your user experience more efficient and to improve our site. Certain cookies are required for the site to function properly. We may use session Cookies (deleted when you close your browser) and persistent cookies (which stay on your computer until deleted).

The following cookies are used on our site:

- Strictly Necessary Cookies These cookies are essential for the site to function properly. Without them we cannot provide the services you have asked for. For example, remembering your login details to secure areas of the site and some preferences.
- Performance/Analytical Cookies These cookies collect information anonymously on how visitors use our site. This helps us to view the number of visitors, how and when they use the site. For example, we use Google Analytics and the information is only used to improve our website and its services.
- 3. **Functionality Cookies** These cookies remember you when you return to our website. We can personalise our content for you. For example, greet you by name and remember some of your preferences such as your region or language.
- 4. Targeting Cookies These cookies record your visit to our site, pages visited and links followed. This information is used to make our site and display advertising more relevant to your interests. This information may be shared with third parties for these purposes.
- 5. Social Media Cookies These cookies allow you to share what you have been doing on social media such as LinkedIn and Twitter. Please note these cookies are not in our control and you will need to refer to the respective privacy policies for how their cookies work.
